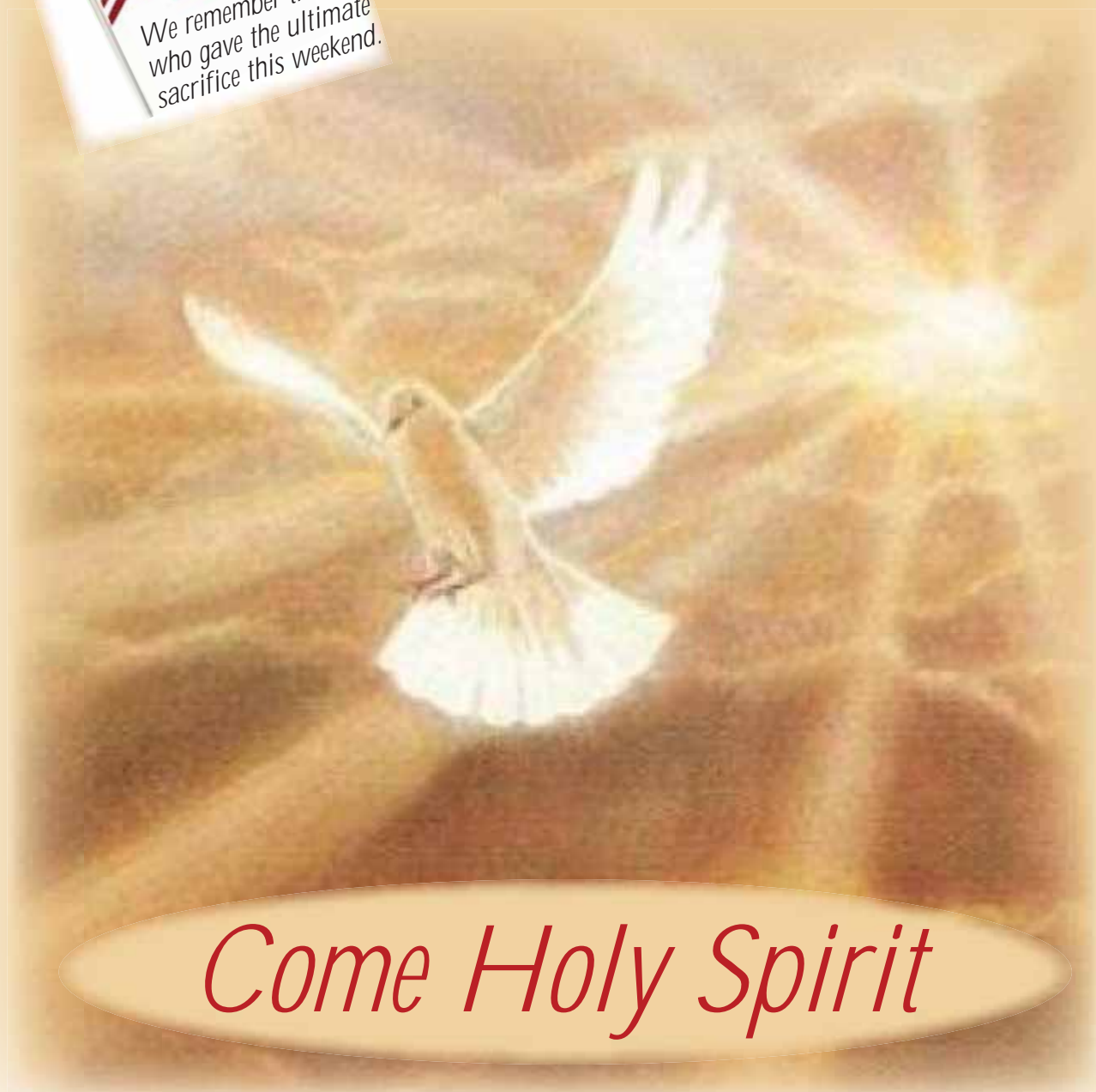
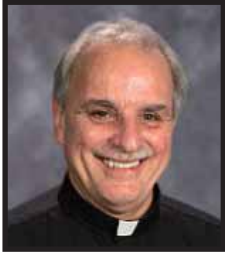

“And suddenly there came from the sky a noise like a strong driving wind, and it filled the entire house in which they were”
(Acts 2:2).

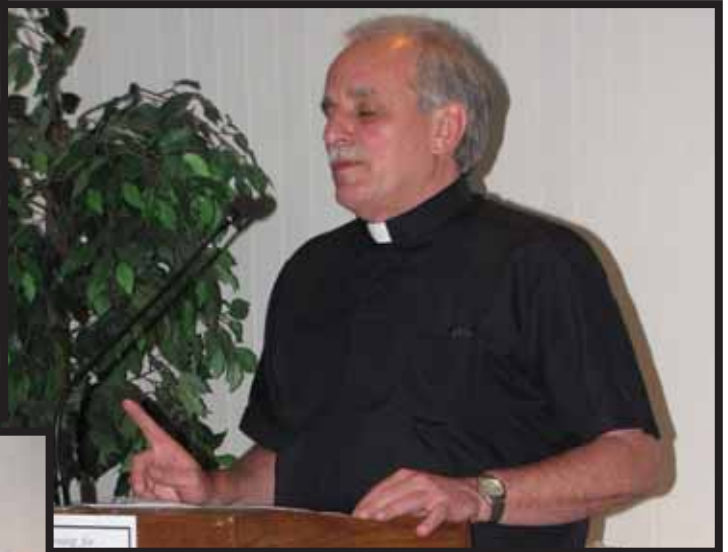
