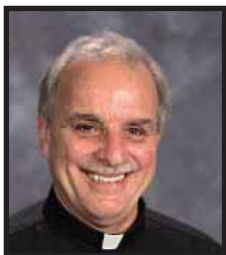

## A Message from Fr. Abe...

### THE ADVOCATE FROM ON HIGH

Jesus reminds us that love is not real unless it is expressed in action. Otherwise, it is merely hypocritical. Love is not the possession of our desires, but the willingness to endure suffering for the sake of the beloved. Love is genuine when we're willing to sacrifice for the good of the beloved. **That is why the God of Love [cf. 1 Jn 4:8] suffered and died on the Cross for us.** That is the greatest love of all. The Lord is asking us to love as He loves.

**God as Advocate.** If we love Jesus, He will ask the Father to give us another Advocate. The first advocate is Jesus Himself. Being our Redeemer, He saved us from Satan and offered us to the Father. The second Advocate is the Holy Spirit.

What do we mean by Advocate? It comes from the Latin word 'Advocatus' – the one that pleads the cause of another before a tribunal and defends his case.

Two of the titles of Satan are: Deceiver [Jn 8:44; Rev 12:9] and Accuser [Rev 12:10]. On the contrary, instead of deceiving, God is Truth, Jesus is our Truth [...Way and Life] and God's Spirit is the Spirit of Truth. Instead of accusing, God's Spirit is our defense lawyer from the lies of the enemy. The presence of the Holy Spirit then completes for us the full revelation of who God is: Creator, Divine Provider, Redeemer and Savior, as well as Sanctifier and Defender. **God fills every fiber of our being, every strata of our life and each movement in our history.**

That is the reason why, for those who believe, God is truly with and within us. He fills our souls and our entire existence. We are never alone because of His ever-active presence in our life. However, it can only be seen through the eyes of faith and it can only be felt by the power of love.

Jesus' invitation to love and do the will of God is a call to live a life worthy of God. **Being created by His image and recipient of the Spirit, the Lord wants us to live a life of holiness and love.** Most of the times we are overburden by temptations of the flesh, but the Spirit of God empowers us to live according to His will.



**"For it is better to suffer for doing good, if that be God's will, than for doing evil." 1 PETER 3:17**
